Patty Cadorin is Vice President and Senior Advisor of BMO Harris Bank. Previously, she was Chief of Staff to the CEO. Prior to the acquisition of Marshall & Ilsley Corporation by BMO Financial Group, Patty was Senior Vice President and Corporate Communications Director for Marshall & Ilsley Corporation.

Patty serves on the board of directors of the United Community Center; the Wisconsin Women's Council (Governor's Designee); Building Brave, the M&I Foundation; and is a member of the

United Way Women's Initiative Leadership Council, and the UPAF Arts Education Grants Panel.
